CARE OF GAURANGI



Some months ago Syam helped a milk farmer in the area, and there we met a milk cow with a very bad opened wound on her back leg. He spoke to the farmer and we started to take care of her. With the help of our good friend Wenda from England (who always give us advice, per telephone, regarding medication for the sick animals) we started to treat the sick cow. Her health improved and her wound healed in few weeks. We were very happy of the results and planned to buy the cow from the farmer. Due to her recovery, the farmer put her again with the other milk cows and we thought she would be fine. However, for pure

curiosity Syam went everyday to check on her to suddenly found out that she did not eat anymore, because the other cows did not let her approach the feeding place. She lost her good condition very fast and we decided to take her out of the stable. It took us 40 minutes to accomplish 20 meters. Syam support her on the back and I guided her on the halter. She was in very bad condition and with the help of the veterinary; we started to treat her with infusions and minerals to nourish her. After 5 days she stood up by



herself and started to eat big portions like in the past. There was good hay and some cereals and vegetables. However, a new problem came up, an open

wound on her hip bone appeared, after a good treatment and daily change of bandage, the wound closed in 3 weeks and on October 10th it was finally healed. Oh, the farmer gave us the cow as present, because he was impressed of our care and we brought her on October 3rd to our stable, where she was friendly welcomed by our love ones. By the way, we gave her the name Gaurangi.



Gaurangi was only 6,5 years old and nevertheless her hard life a very friendly cow, who was very thankful and full of love to everyone who gave her some attention.

Let her be in our hearts for long time.



Our Gaurangi was a very nice cow, and on October 12th we met at the stable with our friends Istvan, Arundhati and Rasa and we nicely brushed and fed all the cows and oxen. It was a very pleasing atmosphere.

But on the next day overtook us a shock. Gaurangi had left us, her body was cold and hard. She laid very peacefully and her eyes were still open. The Vet said she had died from a heart weakness during the night. We are sure that she went to the land of the eternal happiness and peace.



P.S. The veterinary told us that it often happens that a misused milk cow dyes from a weak heart, because they are not meant to produce 8,000 or more liters milk per year.

Hello dear friends and cow protectors,

As you all know we are looking for a new home. A new, bigger and most important safer home for our cows and oxen and for us.

What are we looking for?

A small house with lots of land and if possible a stable and a barn. The land should be at least 4 Hectares and not separate (which means that the whole land must be all enclosed), because we need the land to provide enough food for the animals in summer and winter. It should have a maximum of 15 to 20 hectares, because bigger areas will surpass our working capacity. Of course the land should be predominantly pastures, with some trees and hedges, some forest is also ok.

What are we looking for?

We have evaluated the situation and found out that is not so relevant where the new home is located, the important thing is that the animals have a safe home, and when we find some land on the North West, we would be ready to move there. Of course a place in Bayern is the easiest and most comfortable solution, because the move would be less complex and will cost less money as to move to other regions. For this reason when somebody hear something or know somebody or have an idea, please let us know.

We are ready to take the next step for the expansion of the project and to take new challenges for the welfare of the animals.
